"It's a good thing," said O43 Maintenance Supervisor **Bill Berger**. "Now the crews can look up what parts they need and close out tickets without having to come back into the shop, which has proven to help the back log

of work we have."

The Work Manager app was discovered by Maintenance Engineering Manager **Tom Bales** (O41), who has spent the past eight years researching new ways to leverage mobile technology in the Facilities Division. Bales discovered that the app's appeal was the usability of the program itself, which features a straightforward interface that is easy to use.

O43 Maintenance Technician **Bass Beasley** was one of the first employees to use the Work Manager app. "It gives technicians the ability to access information about their jobs with the touch of a stylus," said Beasley.
