DIVERSITY IS SOMETHING THAT WE DO AT THE SHIPYARD EVERY DAY. WE DON'T PAY ATTENTION TO PEOPLE'S SKIN COLOR, THEIR RACE, OR ANY DISABILITIES THAT THEY MIGHT HAVE. WE SHOULD GO IN TO A JOB KNOWING THAT HEY WE HAVE THIS PERSON ON OUR TEAM AND WE'RE GOING TO UTILIZE THEM TO THE BEST OF THEIR ABILITIES.

INCLUSION MEANS TO ME JUST TRYING TO MAKE EVERYONE FEEL INCLUDED AND ACCEPTING OF ALL PEOPLE.

DIVERSITY MEANS THAT YOU HAVE SO MANY OPPORTUNITIES TO HAVE SO MANY DIFFERENT POINTS OF VIEWS, SO MANY WAYS TO LOOK AT AN ISSUE, AND SOLVING A PROBLEM.
