



Newport News Shipbuilding celebrated Martin Luther King Jr.'s legacy with events for shipbuilders. The theme for NNS' second annual MLK Day commemoration was "The Color of Unity." First and second shift celebrations were held Jan. 12, and a third shift celebration took place on the morning of Jan. 16.

Guest speaker **Edmond Hughes**, vice president of Human Resources and Administration at Ingalls Shipbuilding, shared his personal story and talked about the progress made in his native Mississippi, across the United States and within Huntington Ingalls Industries.

"There are so many positive examples of how our country has changed over the years. We each play a role in making it a better place," he said. "I've been pleased with the energy HII has placed on the inclusion and diversity initiative. The fact that we are having this event today is a testament to that commitment."

NNS President **Jennifer Boykin** spoke about the importance of diversity to the nation and the shipyard. 

Award recipients disclosed three new and useful inventions that NNS decided to protect by filing non-provisional patent applications. "Parking has been and continues to be a frustration for much of our workforce, and the company is committed to improving this quality-of-life issue," said **Matt Needy**, vice president of Operations. "As part of our *Enabling Our Workforce* NNSFORWARD Strategy, we established a tiger team devoted to parking. This employee-led team came up with some great ideas – some of which are being implemented now. In conjunction with Facilities, this team will continue to look at innovative ways to make immediate changes and also plan for long-term parking solutions. Adding the additional 500 spaces to Hidens is the first of many improvements that employees will see this year."

As a reminder, the following parking garages are open and available to Newport News Shipbuilding employees:

- Bldg. 902 Garage:
 - Location: Warwick Boulevard between 26th and 28th streets
 - The ramp to the top deck and the entire top deck of this garage (214 spaces) is available to employees with any color NNS parking decal. The external shuttle stop for this location is at the Bldg. 903 Garage and can transport employees to the 50th, 46th, 42nd, and 31st street gates, where they can use the shipyard's internal shuttle to get to the North Yard.
- Bldg. 903 Garage:
 - Location: Warwick Boulevard between 28th and 30th streets
 - The ramp to the top deck and the entire top deck of this garage (197 spaces) is available to employees with any color NNS parking decal. The external shuttle stops at this garage and can transport employees to the 50th, 46th, 42nd, and 31st street gates, where they can use the shipyard's internal shuttle to get to the North Yard. *Note: Do not park in spaces labeled, "Reserved for MDC." These spaces are reserved for employees attending meetings at the Management Development Center.*
- Navy Garage:
 - Location: West Avenue between 30th and 31st streets
 - NNS employees can park on the top two decks of this garage (approximately 600 spaces) through the end of March. The external shuttle picks up at the 31st Street Gate and will transport employees to the 50th Street Gate, where they can use the shipyard's internal shuttle to get to the North Yard.

Corrective Action Request (CAR) Team Beats Stretch Goal

Newport News Shipbuilding delivered three ships to the U.S. Navy in May 2017. In the three months that followed, Quality Program Management (O06) identified nearly 130 outstanding corrective action requests (CARs) across programs. In response, the CAR team – which is responsible for working with NNS programs to help resolve and prevent recurrence of Navy-identified issues – established a stretch goal to reduce the backlog.

Dubbed "100 CARs in 100 days," the effort required the CAR Team to gain Supervisor of Shipbuilding (SUPSHIP) approval to clear new and outstanding CARs to reduce the backlog to 100 in as many days, and was aggressive given the rates of CARs received and cleared.

The team was able to reduce the backlog to less than 100 by day 56, well ahead of the goal. The team celebrated the milestone with a cake. Additional issues were identified in the following weeks, bringing the number of outstanding CARs past 100 once again. However, the team continued working toward the goal, and on day 100, the number of open CARs was down to 93. The team is now evaluating goals for 2018.

In 2017, O06 changed its name and purpose, becoming Quality Problem Management, a department dedicated to supporting NNS with a comprehensive problem management solution. In addition to the CAR team, O06 also has teams tasked with leading material investigations and unplanned events.




