Dear Technical Solutions colleagues:

If you are telecommuting, take all necessary precautions to protect you and your family: Follow government directions about remaining home and going out only when absolutely necessary, maintain appropriate social distancing, and wash your hands frequently.
- **Time-Charging:** If you are telecommuting, you may be balancing work with other commitments (family needs, home schooling, etc.). While there is flexibility in how you manage your time, there is none in how we charge it. We all have an obligation to record our time accurately every single day.
