For more than 10 years, as a partner in the joint venture Savannah River Nuclear Solutions, we have effectively managed and operated the site, supporting critical national security missions and the safe, responsible cleanup of legacy waste. Awarded in 2008, this \$12+ billion contract has been extended through at least 2021.

N3B focuses on environmental monitoring and remediation, waste management and disposition, and decontamination and decommissioning at the LANL site.
